Dear families,

We are going to begin a study of clothes. We need your help to gather a collection of clothes to investigate. We need clothes of all sizes, types, colors, and fabrics. Here's a list of suggestions, but you may also send in clothes that are not on the list. Please label the clothes with your name so we can return them to you at the end of our study. We promise to take good care of them!

Buttons, jackets, coats, windbreakers, raincoats, blazers, vests, sweaters, t-shirts, turtlenecks, blouses flannel shirts, jeans, pants, skirts, dresses, shorts, pajamas, bathrobes, neckties, bow ties, scarves, belts suspenders, gloves, mittens, socks, tights, shoes, boots, old-fashioned clothes, uniforms, costumes, and more!

As we study clothes, we will learn concepts and skills in literacy, math, science social studies, the arts, and technology. We'll also use thinking skills to investigate, ask questions, solve problems, make predictions, and test our ideas.

What You Can Do At Home

Talk with your child about clothes. Examine the fabrics together and discuss how the clothes were made. Look at the labels to find out where the clothes were made and identify the fabric. Look at pictures from the past and note how the clothing differs from clothing today.

When you shop for clothes, help your child notice how clothes are organized in the store and offer a simple explanation of how you compare prices.

Home Connection: Things to point out while reading together:

- Talk about specific letters.
- Point out special words.
- Show your child the first word of a sentence.
- Show your child the last word of a sentence.
- Point out the first and last words on a page.
- Discuss punctuation marks and what they mean.
- Point out capital letters. Tell your child that a sentence always begin with a capital letter.
- Ask your child to show you a lowercase letter.
