At this time the staggered entry and dismissal time and recess times will remain to assist with reducing congestion and to support social distancing practices outside and entering the building. Our current recess times ensure that a maximum of 100 students are in each of the playground areas. Our school administration team is visiting all of the classrooms to provide an orientation to our school and to review new practices and guidelines. The students at Holy Family school are respectful and are eager to be helpful towards one another; we are blessed.

Our grade 4 and 5 students are unique as they are required to wear masks at school; we are supporting our students and prompting them at times when they can remove their masks including when they are sitting at their desks and are forward facing according to the guidelines shared in the school re-entry plans. If students are standing and moving around the classroom they are prompted to wear their masks. We have noticed that several students are choosing to wear their masks all day including recess times. Our staff will continue to prompt students when it is a good time to remove their masks so they can get a break from wearing a mask.
