Core Curriculum:

Students are expected to write in complete sentences in all subject areas. We will be working on Narrative writing this month, paying special attention to elaborative details.

Spelling: I am sending home a list of frequently misspelled spelling words. Please see your child's list and practise any of the words they had trouble with. You can keep this list handy and practise a few each night. Thank you!

Social: We will continue to research in text and online about various aspects of Tunisia (traditions, celebrations, services, government, land, resources and environment). They will then create a google presentation on Tunisia that they will be presenting to the class.

Science: We have already begun our next science unit on Hearing and Sound.

This unit will also include a project of a homemade musical instrument. More information and a rubric will be sent home with your child later.
