12.) Trustee's Report: Anne-Marie Watson unable to attend, report shared by Rori-Lynn

- In response to confusion over superintendent survey questions, Anne-Marie has advised that the survey was initially created for teachers to complete. The decision was made to extend the survey to parents, but the wording was not changed from its original format and many found the dialogue confusing as it was initially prepared for those within the education system.
- There were 687 parents who responded to the survey, and 189 staff.
- The survey itself was produced at no cost and though the results are confidential, they
 broadly expressed a focus on faith, building trust, budget considerations, covid
 response, respect and collaboration.
