

Curriculum Update:

Language Arts:

The reading growth in our class this year has been incredible. I am so pleased with how many of our students are on their way to being lifelong readers. This month, our student Language Arts focus will be on:

- writing (story writing) and
- spelling

Math:

We are completing our final units on Shape and Space, and addition/subtraction with 3-Digit numbers. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes. Look for different shapes throughout your home and discuss what the names of them are with your child. Also, it would be of great benefit if your child would continue to practice their basic facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). They should also continue to practice 2 and 3 digit addition and subtraction.

Science:

During June, we will continue with our last unit which is "Animal Life Cycles". Students have been learning about the growth and development of animals and that different animals have different life cycles. We will also be learning about changes in the needs of the young as they grow and develop and about the changing relationship between animals and their environment. We are enjoying our caterpillars and are eagerly awaiting the third stage (Chrysalis). We will have a "Butterfly Release Party" when they are grown.

Social

In Social Studies we are learning about the country of India: land, customs, traditions, celebrations, services and government.

As mentioned, we will culminate the year with a **Grade 3 International Food Day**, where students will have a chance to try a food item from each of the countries we have studied.

If you would like your child to bring in a food item to share from Ukraine, Peru, Tunisia or India, please let me know. In addition, if you would like to send a sampling of food from a country of your heritage, please contact me. We would love to have your child share their heritage with us!
