We will be having school pictures taken at HFS on October 12 at 1:45 pm.

#### Core Curriculum:

**Language Arts:** This month in L.A., we will be journal writing, writing responses to our read-aloud: Third Grade Angels and working on poetry. We will focus on students writing complete sentences with proper capitalization, punctuation and sentence structure. In reading, students have been choosing "good-fit" books and reading literature of their interest and at their personal reading level. I have also assigned students books to read on our EPIC online reading program. Students can access books at their levels on this website from home as well. As a class, we will also be reviewing our short and long vowel sounds; as well as blends and digraphs.

<u>Math</u>: - We will continue to work in the number concepts unit this month. We are learning to represent and rename numbers to 1000 with numerals, words, pictures and base ten blocks. We will eventually cover place value up to 100 000.

Please try to play some cards or dice games with your child at home. Crib, Yahtzee and Snakes and Ladders are great games to play. The students have also learned to play Junk It, Come to Order, Pickle and 10 Up. <u>Science:</u> - We will be continuing with our Rocks and Minerals unit. Students are comparing rock similarities and differences, learning about the properties of rocks and recognising rock composition. We had fun making cookies and learning how they change with heat and pressure.

<u>Social</u>: - Once we have completed our Mapping Unit, we will begin learning about the 4 countries of **Peru**, **Tunisia**, **Ukraine and India** in the grade 3 curriculum. Our class will take an imaginary flight to each country and learn about their quality of life, customs/traditions, services, land and resources. We will also have a special project culminating the learning about each country. The first country that we will be learning about is the country of <u>Peru</u>. Our flight to Peru will take place during the first few weeks of October. Bon Voyage!
