Dear Parents,
October has gone by very quickly. It is hard to believe we are beginning our third month of school. I am looking forward to discussing your child's growth so far this year on our Parent/Teacher Interview days scheduled for November 8th and 9th.

## Language Arts

Reading: A continued thank you to all of the terrific parents in $2 R$ who are reading every night with their children. They are becoming more fluent readers every day. Please remember to encourage your child to really think about what they are reading. Focusing on comprehension is critical. Please ask your child questions about the story after they have read it, as well as have them retell the story from beginning to end. Encourage them to recall and tell with lots of details.

Spelling Words: A letter was sent through Schoology regarding our new program for Spelling. The following are the spelling words for the month of November. Please practice spelling with your child throughout the week. They will also be working on spelling them at school. They will have a spelling test at the end of the week which will be sent home with them for you to see.

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## Math:

In the new Math Curriculum, the students need to know how to count money. They have learned the value of each coin and are using skip counting to count a variety of coins. This is VERY DIFFICULT for many of them. If you have time to practice counting coins at home, that would really help with this skill.

## Science:

We are continuing to work on our Exploring Liquids unit. The students are moving into the part of the unit where they will explore the states of matter of solids, liquids and gasses. They are learning lots of new vocabulary and have really been enjoying our experiments.


## Social Studies:

We are continuing to study the geography of Iqaluit Nunavut, Meteghan Nova Scotia and Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. The students have really enjoyed learning about the Arctic, Atlantic and Prairie regions. They are getting very good at distinguishing the similarities and differences of each of these regions. Recently we have been discussing the landforms as well as the bodies of water in each of these regions.
