#### Math:

The children will soon be finishing their first numeracy unit and will begin to work on the second unit about Place Value. They will be focusing on ones, tens and hundreds place value in numbers to 1000.

#### Science:

We are completing our unit on <u>Exploring Liquids</u>. When it is finished, we will begin our unit on <u>Hot and Cold Temperatures</u>. The students will be able to recognize the effects of heating and cooling and will be able to identify methods for heating and cooling.

#### Social Studies:

We are continuing to study the geography of Iqaluit Nunavut, Meteghan Nova Scotia and Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. The students are now learning about the climate in the Arctic, Atlantic and Prairie regions. They will be exploring the differences and similarities of the climate in each region.
