<u>Religion:</u>

During Lent, please remind your child to check their Lenten calendar each day. We will continue to collect food items for the Red Deer Food Bank. Please donate if you are able.

Language Arts:

We will continue to focus on reading comprehension, reading accuracy, reading fluency and expanding vocabulary. We will also continue working on descriptive writing with elaborative detail. We have been working with the students to write a complete paragraph. They have now finished writing a few paragraphs and will continue to work on developing their writing skills.

<u>Math:</u>

This month we will begin our Fractions unit. Students will be learning about situations in which fractions are used, that fractions represent a part of a whole and will compare fractions of the same whole that have like denominators. (math vocabulary this month: fractions, whole, half, thirds, quarters, denominators, numerators)

<u>Math Facts</u>: It is so important for your children to know their basic facts (addition and subtraction to 18) and that they have a good grasp of adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers. Please have them practice a couple of equations every evening to help improve their fluency and accuracy with these concepts. We will begin 3-digit addition and subtraction soon.



<u>Science</u>: We are finishing off our <u>Hearing and Sound Unit</u>. Our next topic for science is called "<u>Building and Testing with a</u> <u>Variety of Materials"</u>.

Social: This month students will continue to learn about <u>Ukraine</u>. We will read about the traditions and celebrations in Ukrainian culture. We will be discussing their quality of life, the services they need, their resources, their land, their environment as well as their government.
