Highlights

- 100% of parents felt the literacy skills children are learning at school are useful
- 100% of students indicated that they feel students respect and care about each other
- 9.9% increase in satisfaction with Parental Involvement from previous year
- Scored over 90% in 5 of 6 provincial measures
- Above Alberta average in all provincial measures



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Faith Survey Results



- 100% Student agreement on 11 measures from the survey regarding faith programming at Holy Family School. 89% or higher agreement on all measures.
- >90% Parent agreement regarding effectiveness of all elements of faith development and programming at Holy Family School.
- 100% Teachers indicated belief that our school creates opportunities for students to encounter and make connections with our faith through various experiences such as scripture reading, liturgies, sacraments, and celebrations.

- Faith: Increase in staff feeling comfortable sharing their faith
- Student Achievement: Decrease in percentage of students at-risk in literacy
- Teaching and Leading: Teachers focus on *High Impact Teaching Strategies* to assist in implementing new curriculum
